BIG on TOUR is a unique event in the Fixtures calendar and was born to provide good quality High Jump and Long Jump competition in the UK which has been badly lacking over the last few years. 2026 is our Pilot year and we are learning too, so any constructive comments or suggestions will be gratefully received as we look to develop over the series. All necessary equipment (EDM, No Jump cameras, screens, etc) will be in situ to

ensure that qualification marks, be they for European Champs, Euro U18's, World Juniors or even English Schools, will be legal.

Whether you are looking to qualify for a major event in your competition programme, return from injury or just enjoy the experience, you are all very welcome and we hope this meeting will provide a fun, athlete friendly environment in which to qualify whatever your level as well as providing another great opportunity to return to high level competition.

Events on the day are being overseen by highly qualified Officials ably assisted by a small number of Development Officials as we provide a mentoring process to assist them in their journey to working at High Level competitions.

The overall organisation is being handled by BIG and we will be there to assist on the day, answer questions you may have, take suggestions for improvements or future events, and enjoy the day alongside you.

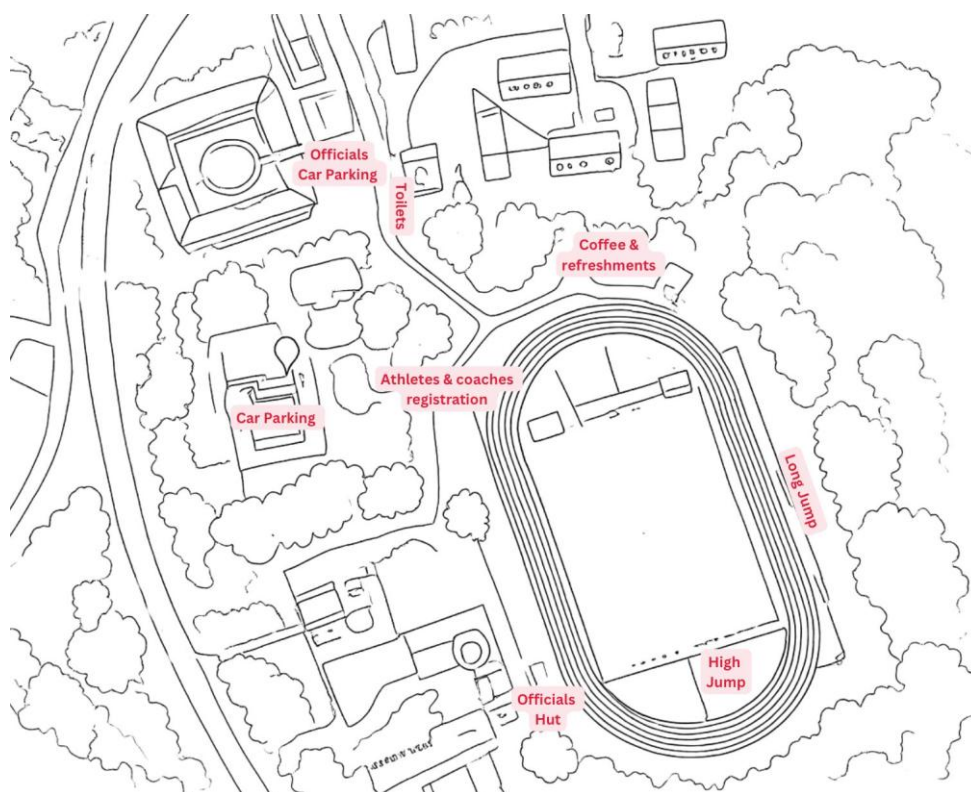
The meeting is a World Athletics Ranking Competition 2026 and has a UKA Level 2 and WPA permit and will be run under WA Rules.

**PLEASE NOTE: Spike lengths will be checked at the competition site. Needle spikes are not recommended**

**High Jump Max 9mm**  
**Long Jump Max 6mm**

**CAR PARK** – Parking for athletes, coaches & spectators is available at the university's Park House Car Park, right next to the track. Access is via Edgbaston Park Road, and what3words for the car park is [///regime.tracks.trees](https://www.what3words.com/#!/regime.tracks.trees). There is a £3 charge for this so please ensure you pay it on arrival as all car parks are now monitored by the University. There is a path directly into the track.

**ATHLETE ENTRY** to the stadium will be the pathway from the Car Park



**ATHLETE REGISTRATION DESK** – will be situated on the top of the bank near the 100m start line

You must register and collect your Bib at least 60 minutes before your event.

**WARM UP AREA** – You may use the track for warm up. There is no indoor facility.

**COACHES PASSES** – There is no need to register in advance for coach accreditation. Please go to the Athlete Registration Desk on Arrival and register there. There will be no charge for entry on this occasion. Please leave your email address and licence details on the form available so we may contact you for future events. Please collect a wristband as **Only those with a wristband will be allowed in the Coaching areas** .

**DISALLOWED EQUIPMENT IN THE COMPETITION AREA** – Athletes are reminded that mobile phones/ iPods, Smart watches, Tablets, cameras, etc must not be taken into the competition area and this will be checked at your event site.

**REPORTING for your Pool** – There will be no FINAL CALL area so please go directly to your competition area 30 minutes before your event start time to begin technical warm up as it will take time to mark & set up run-ups etc. All spikes, kit, disallowed equipment, etc will be checked at your competition site. **PLEASE make sure the previous competition has finished before going to your site**

**SPECTATOR & COACHING AREAS** – As there are no track events it will be possible to get closer to the event sites and these areas will be roped off. **COACHES AREAS** will be designated near all event sites so can you please ask your coaches to adhere to them. When walking between events, please walk round the outside of the track. No seating is available so we advise bringing your own chairs

## HIGH JUMP

**PLEASE NOTE : Despite trying to find a 6 x 4 spike top I have been unsuccessful so unfortunately we are going to have to remain with 3 large pools. I know you will all make the best of this and ask that you work with the Officials on the day to ensure each pool runs to time. Please can we ask that you do not waste time between jumps and are ready to go when called by officials. I will continue to look to source the cover but am not hopeful (even tried Bedford but it is too BIG to go in my car) - so sorry! I will reorder the Pools - even at the last minute - if I am successful!**

- Competitions have been split by performance and two cards (Men & Women) will be run where necessary to make the competition legal.
- Progressions will be decided before the competition and we will look to go through as many of the relevant qualifying standards as possible. We will also ensure starting heights & progressions in each Pool are suitable for this time of the season.
- We will ensure the first height in each competition is comfortable for all.
- Call up will be **30 mins prior to start time**. Call up will be at the High Jump area. **PLEASE make sure the previous competition has finished before going to the site**

## LONG JUMP

- The competitions have been split by performance and two cards (Men & Women) will be run where necessary to make the competition legal.
- All competitions will be measured by EDM with Electronic No-Jump equipment also in use.
- All athletes will have 6 Trials.
- PLEASE NOTE: There will be NO reversal of the jumping order after Round 3.
- **Call up will be 30 mins prior to start time**. Call up will be at the Long Jump site. **PLEASE make sure the previous competition has finished before going to the site**

**SEATING** – There is no spectator seating so we suggest you bring your own.

**MEDICAL COVER** – First Aid cover will be present.

**WATER** – No water will be available so please ensure bring your own water.

**REFRESHMENTS** – There will be a coffee van serving hot & cold drinks, and sandwiches there from 10.00 and a Pizza Van from 12.00

**BIG** cannot accept responsibility for incurred expenses should the meeting be cancelled or postponed, nor can **BIG** accept responsibility for any injury or loss incurred at this event.

**BIG** reserves the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by the promoter's conditions.
